Q. What is the Web & IT team?

Q. When would I serve?

Website management is done at your convenience, working on projects and taking new content and graphics online based on predetermined time lines. Social media management is also done at your convenience based on clear objectives for each week.

Q. How would I know what to work on?

We work as a team through face-to-face meetings, email, and other means. The Web & IT team works with the Media team to align print designs with online environments. We then decide which team members will work on what projects based on time, interests in the project, special skill sets, and deadlines we need to meet.
