

Production | Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What encompasses Production?

The Production team is responsible for all sound, video, and lighting in all of our “foyer” or large group environments. You’ll notice that we usually have a sound technician, a lighting technician, and a computer technician (running all videos and words) on any given Sunday.

Q. What is a typical Sunday like on Production?

For our Sunday morning services, all production volunteers scheduled for that day begin set up at 7 AM in the Curris Center. We are usually ready for sound check with the band at 8 AM and after rehearsal will do a full run through. We will also do any video checks during this time. Production volunteers scheduled for that day are expected to serve for both services. Our Ignite environment happens one Sunday night each month, and production volunteers arrive at 4:30 PM and are finished at 7:30 PM.

Q. Where is there an opportunity for me to serve?

We are always looking for individuals who love technology and have at least some sort of experience working in one of these areas. One of the easiest areas to train on is our computer program that runs all words and videos during a service. This is a great place to start if you are interested in joining Production. However, if you have some experience in sound or lighting, we can train you there as well!

Q. How often would I serve?

Depending on the number of volunteers we have on our team, we would love to schedule you to serve once or twice a month. However, if you are willing to serve more we will definitely use you! We want you to serve as much as you want, but don’t want you to burn out!

Q. If I set up, do I have to tear down?

All we ask is that our production crew tear down all equipment at the production table (sound board, wireless microphone and pack boxes, computers, lighting board, etc.). Then you’re free to go!
